



The Dishwasher position at the Council on Aging of Central Oregon works in the commercial kitchen at the Senior Services Center in Bend. This position is an integral part of the team, allowing the kitchen to run efficiently and effectively to feed hundreds of older Central Oregonians every week. The main responsibility of this position is to provide clean and sanitized cookware for all food prepared in the kitchen and reports directly to the Executive Chef.

Compensation

The salary for this position is between \$16-\$18 per hour

Requirements

Due to the vulnerability of the population we serve, all employees of the Council on Aging must have their COVID vaccination.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities

The essential functions include, but are not limited to the following:

- Perform all duties related to dishwashing and maintaining general cleanliness of the kitchen area.
- Wash, rinse, and sanitize dishes, pots, pans, utensils, and small wares.
- Maintain cleanliness of floors, mats, drains, walls, and shelves in the kitchen area.
- Empty garbage as needed.
- Assist with food prep and packaging as directed.
- Immediately report safety hazards and violations.
- Arrive on time, appropriately groomed, dressed and ready to work.
- Engage in a courteous, friendly, and efficient manner with staff, volunteers and clients.
- Follow and comply, or ensure compliance with health, sanitation, and safe work procedures.

Minimum Qualifications (Knowledge, Skills, and Abilities)

- Ability to use brushes, scrapers and detergents, required.
- Ability to remain standing for long periods
- Ability to work independently with minimal supervision
- Ability to communicate effectively with staff, volunteers and client
- Bilingual preferred

**Physical Demands and Work Environment**

This work requires the following physical abilities:

- Climbing, bending, kneeling, twisting, reaching, standing, sitting, walking, lifting, carrying and relocating 30 lbs.
- Vision abilities required include close vision, distance vision, and ability to adjust focus.
- Finger dexterity for activities such as typing, use of computer mouse, recording money, grasping and repetitive motions.
- Able to withstand extreme temperatures, hot and cold.
